Uniform

PE

This term PE lessons will usually happen outside and, due to this, our PE days might change. Please ensure children's PE kits are in school on a Monday and they will be sent home on a Friday. Children should not wear earrings during PE lessons, so please ensure your child does not wear earrings on our PE day. for PE lessons. **Children will also need outside shoes for playtimes; these can be their PE trainers. They will not be allowed on the trim trail in school shoes.**

Reading

Daily reading of between 10 – 20 minutes continues to be part of the weekly homework. Please encourage your child to read at home each day and, where possible, find opportunities to share books or discuss books that you are reading together. Please can you write into your child's reading record when they have read and we will tick their



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reading record the following morning during our Guided Reading sessions. Children can select books independently based on their shelf.

Times tables

Each week, the children will focus on their times tables. They will then be tested on the Friday. Please practise these at home with your children. You could also use online games such as hit the button or multiplication bingo. Please see the links on our Google Classroom page.

Homework

We have decided to hand homework out on a Thursday and this should be back in by the following Wednesday. Children are expected to complete their homework each week.
