

## ST. KENELM'S SCHOOL: COVID-19 HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT SEPTEMBER 2020

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection.</li> <li>• Adhere to the social distancing guidelines, issued by the Government, to the best of our ability.</li> <li>• Provide a broad and balanced curriculum that appropriately meets the needs of your child's well-being and mental health.</li> <li>• Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of Covid-19.</li> <li>• Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' show symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for 14 days or until the test comes back negative.</li> <li>• Continue our clear and consistent approach to expectations of good behaviour as detailed in our 'Behaviour Policy,' as well as the expectations outlined in this agreement.</li> <li>• Communicate between school and parents via text and newsletters on the school website.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If my child, or anyone else in the household, displays symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school and we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family. I will get them tested and inform the school of the results as soon as I receive them.</li> <li>• If my child, or any other member of their 'bubble', display symptoms of COVID-19, I will collect them from school immediately.</li> <li>• At drop off and pick up, I will observe the 2 metre rule and on my commute to school.</li> <li>• I will stick strictly to the drop off and pick up times allocated to my child.</li> <li>• My child must not bring any items to school other than those on the list.</li> <li>• I will need to remind my child about social distancing but accept that my child may not always do this successfully.</li> <li>• I will support the "Catch it, Bin it, Kill it" guidelines and will remind my child about hygiene.</li> <li>• I will not be allowed to enter the school site and can only communicate being via email or phone.</li> <li>• I will support all staff, who are trying to create the safest possible environment during this crisis.</li> <li>• I will read all letters and texts sent to parents/carers.</li> <li>• I will inform the school immediately of any changes to emergency contacts.</li> <li>• I accept that my child will be taught in a class bubble, which will be isolated from other groups.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Adhere to social distancing rules in classroom and playground.</li> <li>• Tell an adult if I feel unwell.</li> <li>• Not bring items from home except those listed.</li> <li>• Only use equipment provided for me by the school and no other.</li> <li>• Not mix with other children from other class bubbles.</li> <li>• Only enter and exit the school building via my designated gate.</li> <li>• Follow good hygiene: regular washing of hands for 20 seconds, using provided hand sanitiser, sneezing into tissues provided and disposing of them in bin, coughing into elbow.</li> <li>• Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others.</li> </ul>
