**As Historians** we will learn about the lives of a significant individual from the past who has contributed to national and international achievements.

Based on the book 'Bone Girl' children will learn about Mary Anning. They will gather information using historical records and affirm their knowledge through re-enactment.

**As Geographers** we will develop our awareness of the coast around the United Kingdom and coastal features.

We will explore the British weather using charts and by creating measuring instruments.

### Science

#### Plants

Children will use the school environment to explore and answer questions about growing plants. They will observe the growth of vegetables and flowers that have been planted and devise a healthy meal.

They will become familiar with the names of flowers and trees and identify plant structures.

#### Wonderful weather

The children will be weather watchers. They will be measuring rainfall, wind direction and temperature.
