Dear Parents,

I hope you have all had an enjoyable summer and that your child is looking forward to this year in the Year 3/4 class. It has been lovely to see all the children back in school and we have had a wonderful start to the new school year. Thank you for your support with the new arrangements for when your child arrives and leaves school each day – you have helped to make the return to school a great success.

This term our topic is called 'Magical Mummies', which takes the children on a journey about the Egyptians across the curriculum. Please see the topic map for further details.

## Spelling

All Lower Key Stage Two children get sent home their new spellings on a Monday and will be tested on a Friday. At the start of every term, a spelling overview will be sent home and this will also be available on Google Classroom.

Children will have a LCWC (Look, Cover, Write, Check) sheet sent home on a Monday, it is vital that they fill in their spellings each day and bring it in for us to check. This supports not only their learning of spelling but also their handwriting.

## PE

PE lessons take place on a Tuesday and Thursday. Please ensure your child has an outdoor PE kit and outdoor trainers in school for their PE lesson. Children should not wear earrings during PE lessons, so please ensure your child does not wear earrings on a Tuesday or Thursday. Children with longer hair should also ensure that it is fully tied back for PE lessons. PE kits will be sent home on Friday to be washed and are to be returned to school on the Monday. Children will also need outside shoes for playtimes, these can be their PE trainers.

## Homework

Maths or English homework will be set each Wednesday; this will come home in a homework book. Please follow the instructions carefully and send homework back in on a Monday. The homework will consolidate the work covered in Maths and English. I encourage all children to complete the homework on time.

Daily reading of between 10 – 20 minutes continues to be part of the weekly homework. Please encourage your child to read at home each day and where possible find opportunities to share books or discuss books that you are reading together. Please can you write into your child's reading record when they have read and we will tick their reading record the following morning during our guided reading sessions. Children can select books independently based on where they are on the shelf.
