Vocabulary

New vocabulary is taught in all English lessons and through all subjects. In Maths lessons, we will be focusing on the following areas: **Number** Addition and subtraction within 20. Place value within 50 (multiples of 2, 5, 10 to be included).

Measurement

Length and height. Weight and volume.

Consolidation All skills will be regularly revisited across the year.

PE:

Pupils will be focusing on movement and dance.

As **Historians** and **Geographers** pupils will learn how their locality fits into wider geography. They will also focus on the difference between villages, towns and cities.

As **Musicians** pupils will learn to recognise percussion instruments, experiment with sounds and listen to music. They will use symbols and pictures to record their compositions.

Science: Everyday Materials

In Science, pupils will distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made

Identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock

Describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials

Compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties

Art/Design Technology:

In Art, children will learn to use collage and be inspired by the work of the artist Henri Matisse.

Pupils will also learn mark making techniques and be inspired by the artist Vincent Van Gogh.

In Design Technology, children will design and make a house for The Three Little Pigs.

RE

This term, our values are **Compassion** and **Respect** In RE, we will be exploring Judaism and Christianity through these questions: Do we need shared places? How should people care for the World?

Computing

In Computing, pupils will explore the questions:

Pencil or keyboard?

How can we group data?
